EBN Q&A

Your first Week in Vienna!

How to get from the airport to your accommodation?

Rapid transit railway: The cheapest option to get to the airport is to take the rapid train (S-Bahn) "S7" direction of "Wolkersdorf" or "Wien Floridsdorf".

It runs every 30 min and costs you € 4.50. If you have a semester pass or any other valid ticket for Vienna (24h ticket for € 8.00), then you only have to buy one from the airport until the station "Schwechat" (€ 2.10).

We recommend to buy a weekly ticket at the airport because you need to fill out your "Meldezettel" (you will receive that one at your accommodation) before you can buy the semester ticket. The weekly ticket amounts to € 19.70.

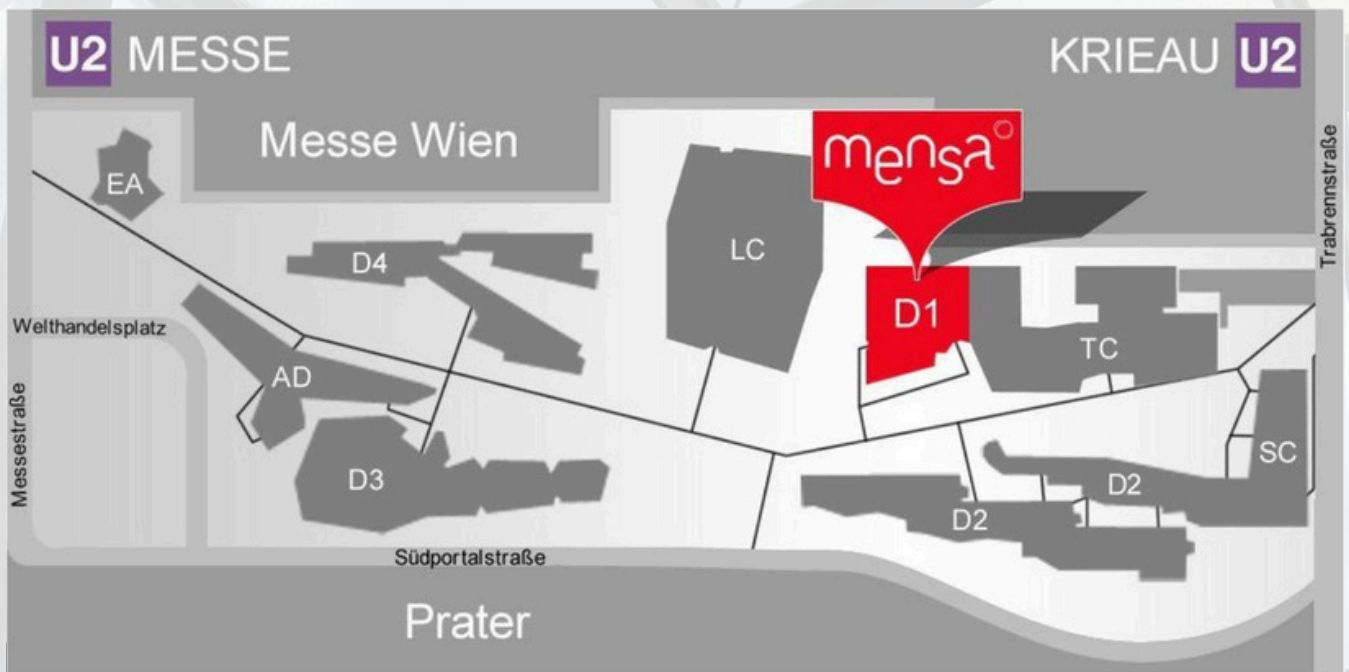


What are good spots for lunch at the WU campus?

You can have lunch in the WU Mensa, "Bashly", "Finn" or "Das Campus", all located on campus. Close to the campus are also "L'osteria" or "Burgers Bar". If you don't feel like having a full meal, you can always buy a snack in "Spar" which is directly on WU Campus, or at "Billa" very close by. 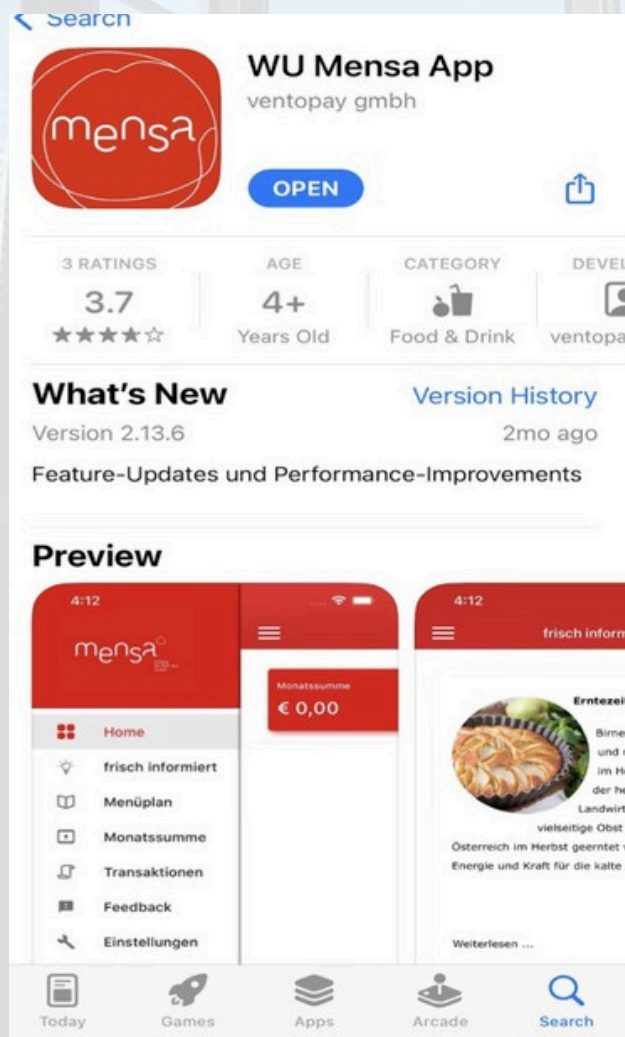
Where is the WU Mensa and how does the WU Mensa card work?

For the enrollment you will get an e-mail where you can sign up for a timeslot to enroll. Make sure to bring your passport or ID, nomination letter and debit or credit card, if you were not able to pay the student's union dues (also called the ÖH fee) online in advance.

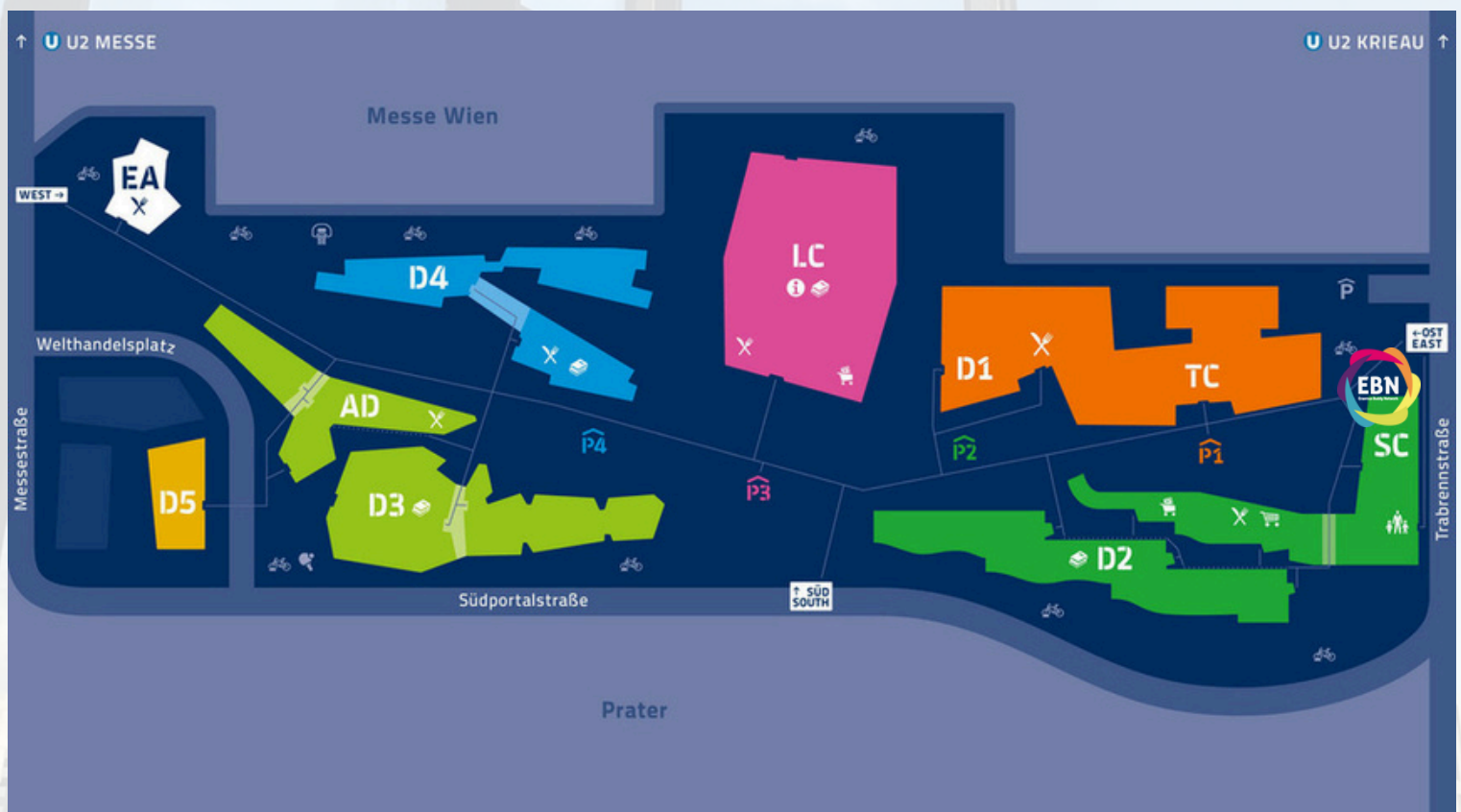

How can I find my way through the university?

SC – Student Center.

Also very important for you as a student, as you'll find here:

- Austrian Student Union at WU (**ÖH WU**) / **EBN Office**
- Students Associations (e.g. AISEC)
- Sports Center

AD – Administration: Here you'll find the rector's office, conference halls etc.

TC – Teaching Center: Most of the courses are held in this building. The big lecture halls as the Audimax and most smaller lecture halls are located here.

D1 – D4: Departments 1-4: Here you'll find all the various Departments and Institutes of WU. (e.g. Department of Finance, Department of Marketing etc.).

Depending on the courses you take, lessons may also take place in the department buildings.

Also, special libraries are located in these buildings as the following:

D2: Library of Business Communication

D3: Library for Law

D4: Library for Social Sciences

EA: Executive Academy

LC: Library and Learning Center: Very important services are located here, such as:

- International Office (IO)
- Study Service Center (SSC) with Admissions Office etc.
- Library Center

The SB-Terminals, where you can validate your student ID, are also located in the LC.

Furthermore, you can find the Ceremonial Hall ("Festsaal").

Club rooms and computer rooms are also there.

How to get my “Meldezettel” (registration of residency):

The Meldezettel should be provided by your renter. If you booked a private accommodation your renter is supposed to hand it to you and sign it after you have filled it out.

Accommodation in a dorm: They will either give it to you when you pick up your keys, you can find it in your room or ask the reception for it.

After that you have to book an appointment at a registration office.

The ÖH WU (Students Union):

What are the tasks of the ÖH and how much is the ÖH fee? The ÖH WU is an organization, which represents the rights of all students to all the relevant bodies and provides services to those students. The members of the ÖH are all the students in Austria, as membership is compulsory. YOU are member of the ÖH as well! By paying the so-called "ÖH fee" of EUR 24.70 upon admission, you become a member of ÖH. The fee helps ÖH providing service to the students and also gets you an accident and third party liability insurance.

The International Office:

What is the International Office and what are the tasks of it?

Internationalization is one of WU's main strategic priorities. The majority of WU students gain international experience through a stay abroad at one of our 240 partner universities, during an International Short Program or with an online exchange initiative.

The International Office reports to the Vice-Rector for Academic Programs and Student Affairs and is WU's central service unit for the coordination of international partnerships, networks, and programs.

Around 1,000 WU students complete an international experience abroad each year. Each year, just as many international students come to WU as incoming exchange students. The International Office is the first point of contact for these students. They advise and inform students about their stay abroad and about options to internationalize their studies at WU. Their goal is to enable all students to acquire a global mindset.

Mobility programs such as ERASMUS+ or CEEPUS are open to university faculty and staff. The International Office highly encourages the WU staff and faculty to spend time at a partner university in order to bring new impulses and innovation to WU.

WU gives its faculty and students access to a network of about 240 partner universities worldwide. The International Office is responsible for developing and supervising these international partnerships.

Conditions of Travel and Payment

The following terms and conditions are valid between the Austrian Students Union (ÖH WU) at the Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration, named as “WE” and the participant, named as “YOU” and “PARTICIPANT”. The terms and conditions are valid from 01.02.2023.

Neither we nor the organizer of the trip / event in person are in any way liable for accidents or other damage occurred during the trip / event and also not for any damage or punishable act caused by the participant. Every participant is responsible for him- / herself. Participation is at your own risk. We also exclude any liability concerning lost or stolen baggage and / or valuables. Furthermore, it's up to the participant to make sure he / she is adequately insured.

By signing the payment confirmation, you agree that we are allowed to use pictures / videos taken of the participant during the trip / event.

Every activity which includes transportation in the price is considered a trip. Every activity which doesn't include transportation in the price is considered an event.

Cancellation policy for online bookings on ebnwu.com:

In case of the cancellation of an **online booking on ebnwu.com**, EBN WU will be forced to charge cancellation fees in the following amounts:

- Up to 72 hours (3 days) before the start of the event 10% cancellation fees
- Within 72 hours (3 days) before the start of the event 100% cancellation fees

However, for trips, the following different cancellation fees and conditions apply:

- Up to 21 calendar days before the start of the trip.....10% cancellation fees (90% refund)
- Within 21 calendar days before the start of the trip.....100% cancellation fees (0% refund)

Exception: Ski trip to Zell am See:

- Up to 30 days before the start of the trip 10% cancellation fees (90% refund).
- Within 30 days before the start of the trip 100% cancellation fees (0% refund).

Exception:

You bring a person who is taking your spot and pays for it.....full refund

- In this case you must send us an email to ebn@oeh-wu.at with the full name, e-mail and phone number of the person taking your spot

No-show without cancellation.....no refund

Exception Zell am See Ski Trip:

- If you want to bring a person who is taking your spot, it's only possible 7 days before the trip starts.
 - In this case you must send us an email to ebn@oeh-wu.at with the full name, e-mail and phone number of the person taking your spot

Exception Kraków Trip:

- If you want to bring a person who is taking your spot, it's only possible 7 days before the trip starts due to the heavy Auschwitz-Birkenau cancellation policy.

In this case you must send us an email to musya.issayev@oeh-wu.at with the full name, e-mail and phone number of the person taking your spot

Zell am See Ski Trip:

We can withdraw from the contract without delay if the participant lastingly disturbs the carrying out of the trip / event. All costs occurred due to the participant's dismissal are at the participant's own expense and there will be no refund. We can also withdraw from the contract if unforeseeable circumstances like natural phenomena, strikes or severe illness of the organizer force us to do so. Benefits not taken are non-refundable. Finally, we reserve the right to cancel bookings for full refund if the number of participants is too small.
